Restoring a Madera Landmark

Part of the plan for the Cultural Arts Center is the renovation of the 100-year-old Historic Madera County Library. This beautiful 7000 square foot building has been sitting vacant and neglected for far too long.

The biggest obstacle to the Madera County Arts Council's mission is our woefully inadequate 1400 square feet of space. For 7 months our landlords allowed us use of a vacant storefront to expand our programs. We were able to offer painting classes to children and adults, workshops for seasoned and begining artists, a performance space for the County finals of the national Poetry Out Loud competition and a gallery space to showcase the art of our youth from all over our county. I want to sincerely thank our landlords for allowing us use of that space, as it demonstrated there is a very real need for our services.

Unfortunately, since the space became unavailable on May 1st, those new programs came to a screeching halt.

Step one of creating a Cultural Arts District is the renovation of this building. It will increase our space 5 fold and will include a spacious gallery, gift shop, event kitchen, large classroom space, a kiln and potters wheels, a coffee/internet bar and individual artist's studios.
















A note from our Executive Director:
